



LA Governors – Eligibility criteria for nominees

Background

The School Governance (Constitution) (England) Regulations 2012, Local authority governor, Regulation 8

In these Regulations “local authority governor” means a person who —

(a) is nominated by the local authority; and

(b) is appointed as a governor by the governing body having, in the opinion of the governing body, met any eligibility criteria that they have set.

The governing board must discuss and agree the criteria that they are seeking in a nominee for the LA governor post. This must be submitted to the local authority prior to or when a vacancy occurs. The completion and submission of this form supports that duty.

The governing board appoint the nominee if they are in agreement that the nominee has the skills to contribute to the effective governance and success of the school, and that the nominee meets any other criteria that the governing board has set. Any formal LA governor appointment must be discussed and agreed at a full governing board meeting, and clearly recorded in the minutes, along with the term of office for the nominee.
