We launched our *Speak out Stay safe* programme in primary schools across the UK so that generations of children have the knowledge and understanding they need to stay safe from abuse and neglect.

So far we have reached 82% of UK primary schools, and we would love your school to be next!

The programme supports you in helping children to:

- understand abuse in all its forms and recognise the signs of abuse
- know how to protect themselves from all forms of abuse
- know how to get help, and the sources of help available to them, including our Childline Service

✓ The programme also helps with your responsibility to provide evidence that your school is meeting new safeguarding inspection requirements.



How we work in primary schools

- We aim to reach every primary school in the UK and visit schools on a 3 year rolling programme.
- The programme is delivered free of charge. However schools will be offered the opportunity to fundraise for the NSPCC if they wish.

The programme provides child-friendly, interactive assemblies and workshops:

Assemblies:

- Rec/KS1 - 20 mins
- KS2 - 30 mins

Workshops:

- Years 5 & 6 – 1 hour
