## What makes governance effective?


- We support 15,000+ boards and over 140,000





## Overview of the BFRP programme

The better financial reporting programme (BFRP) is looking to improve the existing end-to-end process for financial reporting initially by academy trusts.

Key areas of work across the programme include:






Reassessing the financial data that we collect from trusts to ensure that it is **complete, relevant** and only collected once

Introducing **automated data collection** wherever possible to reduce the need for filling in lengthy forms



#### VMFI solution development timeline

Since 2019 VMFI has progressed from Discovery to the launch of two Beta versions of the solution



We are continually looking at improving VMFI and at times during development do need volunteers to take part in research sessions of approximately 45-minute.



## How to Access View my financial insights (VMFI)

#### Getting set up for the first time:

Your school will need to approve your request and we would suggest you contact them before you start the process – approvers in schools tend to be the School Business Manager or the finance team.

1. Register for a <u>Dfe Sign in (DSI) account</u>.

The email registered would need to be in the format name@business. Personal email addresses e.g. @hotmail are not accepted.

2. <u>Request a Role</u> - your account will need permission to access the VMFI tool which is granted through a VMFI role, these are found under the **View Your Education Data** service.

#### Logging in:

- 1. Go to the view your education data service, select your organisation type and sign in.
- 2. Select Academies and schools financial reporting and then View my financial insights tool (VMFI) to access the tool and guidance.

For Board members of Trusts, you will require access through our IDAMs system to have a trust level account and please contact the IDAMs super user in your trust – this would probably be the CFO.
